Okay, not snakes, but these are certainly a part of maintaining them. Just two months prior to needing small mouse pinkies, I replace older mouse breeders with young adults. The result is many and small pinkies. About half of the pinkies in this daily harvest were under 2 grams in weight. I use CO₂ gas to euthanize the pinkies prior to freezing. This time of year we harvest between 300 and 450 pinkies per DAY. Not bad for 88 mouse cages.
