



Over the years, many people have asked what the difference is between Reverse Okeetee and SMR Fluorescent. I don't say that all cases are parallel to the comparative offered in toDAY's SOTD feature, but the snakes in toDAY's comparison between Reverse Okeetee and SMR Fluorescent represent the average phenotypes of respective SMR morphs. Featured pic shows Reverse Okeetee (top) and two Fluorescent corns below it. What makes the white saddle margins POP in the Fluorescent Amels is the absence of white "clutter" in both ground and saddle zones, unlike the white stippling and softer colors on most Reverse Okeetees.
