More images of yesterDAY's MicroScale Butter corn snake mutant. Notice the different shapes of body zone scalation, but also the occasional random anomalously shaped scales, here and there? Why there seems to be a lateral delineation between the dorsal and doro-lateral scales and the start of the lower lateral mid-line scales, I can't explain the lower half of the body being wider than the upper lateral body (at blue arrow point)? I am not implying that all MicroScale corn mutants have this, but it's overtly noticeable on this snake. Is this because of different scale thicknesses, or musculature? **Bonus PIC . . .**
