Macro view of the head scales on the Cayenne Fire featured on February 5, two DAYS ago. Aberrant-*or even missing*-Frontal Scales (bell-shaped center scale) is not exceedingly rare in corns, but this one demonstrates that the aberrancy also impacts adjacent scales whose peripheral shapes usually match those of adjunct scales.
