2015 male Gray-banded Kingsnake (*Lampropeltis alterna*) that is from the Granite-pattern line. Females of this “morph” show little or no orange, emulating the namesake Granite stone, while males have more obvious orange markings, if not usually aberrant, and often chaotic?
