Comments: Superior breeding potential.

The parents of this 36" 2011 Common corn snake were a Butter female corn bred to a Pied-sided Bloodred male. She was not brumated, but I estimate her chances of breeding this summer at perhaps 35%. She's eating frozen/thawed hopper mice. I held back too many babies with this genotype, so I'm parting with one of them. If you have a P/S Bloodred or a Butter, you either of these compound mutants representing four recessive mutations; Amel + Caramel = Butter & Pied-sided with Bloodred. If you have a snake with one or both copies of all these mutations, you have a chance of producing the target product; Pied-Sided Butter Bloodred (aka: Pied-sided Sulfur).
