Most snakes that are about to shed are said to be "*in the blue*", so-termed for the color rendered by separation of the outer skin generation soon to be sloughed. Blue Motleys (Dilute Anery Motleys) take that phrase to a new level. The gene mutation, Dilute, that is added to-*in this case* Anery Motleys-renders an appearance similar to the gene mutation that gives some dogs *like Shetland Sheepdogs* their added namesake color; *Blue Merle*.
