

## Show & Tell



2017 Scaleless corn from parents, HET SCALELESS SUNGLOW MOTLEY x HET SCALELESS SUNGLOW MOTLEY. The exaggerated sheen on the sides-which also smooths out the wrinkles Scaleless serpents always exhibit-is because of distension after resorption of its huge yolk before emerging from the egg. Why this one has such faded markings is a mystery to me, since it's the first one from this line not to have bold markings?

reminder: ALL Scaleless corns in the hobby toDAY (including SCALED corns that are carriers of the Scale-less mutation-aka Het Scaleless) are descendants of the original pairing of a Corn Snake to an Emory's Ratsnake (aka: Great Plains Ratsnake) and are therefore technically inter-species hybrids. **Bonus pic**
