One of the newest gene mutations in the species, *Bogertophis subocularis*, this fully striped TP Ratsnake is amazing. Since introducing the first Albino Trans-pecos (aka: suboc) to our hobby back in 1989, I've waited a long time to see a fourth mutation demonstrated in this species. In their order of discovery, the currently proven gene mutations in Subocs are; Blonde, Axanthic, Albino, and Stripe. Darren sent me a picture of a completely pattern-less Suboc that he hatched, so that *COULD* be another mutation, once its mode of inheritance is proven?
