My goal recently in the realm of Sunkissed mutants is to try to produce classic Motley pattern. Most of the Sunkissed Motley-types in the hobby toDAY exhibit little of what we've all come to know as classic Motley pattern. Other than trying to restore the classic Motley body pattern with circles of ground zone color down the back that are mostly connected, I'm trying to get Sunkissed Motleys back to the classic belly that is devoid of checkering on most Motley mutants that are not Sunkissed. Many Sunkissed Motleys have partial belly checkering, albeit sporadic and low in volume.
