

## Show & Tell



What first appears on this High-white Reverse Okeetee hatchling to be skin showing between scales is demonstrated in the inset macro shot to actually be color-less zones ON scales ground zone scales. This snake is a little over weight (*see the folds on the body profile in the center of the portrait shot*), so one would mistakenly expect all of the “grey” lace pattern to be skin showing between scales. As you can see, all of the scales are touching, exposing no skin between.
