The parents of these 2016 newly hatched corns are a Tesseract Het Opal and an Opal that never looked like one, so this gray Tesseract will probably reveal lavender-ish colors after its first shed. I see at least one Opal Tesseract in the small brood and two obvious Opal Tesserats. Two non-Tesseract pale ones look like Snows, but may not be. Hence, even though these dark ones look like Aneries or Moonstones, their color after they shed will likely reveal that they are not Anery-type mutants. I'll keep you posted. Not that I wouldn't LOVE for these two dark ones to be Moonstones?
