This 28" male 2015 Red Factor Snow Tessera (aka: Coral Snow Tessera) corn snake is currently eating frozen/thawed hopper mice. He is considered a Visual-het because she possesses (and exhibits) only one of the paired gene mutation copies of the dominant-to-wild-type gene mutation, Red Factor. Of course, the Tessera gene mutation is dominant to wild-type, so this snake represents a superior advantage to making exceptional morph compounds without waiting two generations of familial breeding.
