



People keep telling me I'm crazy when I say that our Red Mask mutants are not recessive to wild type, but here again is an F1 out-cross of a Sunglow Motley to a single mutant Anery.

The anery parent is not het for any other mutations, and yet, it's plain to see that this Anery demonstrates the Red Mask mutation. Approximately 1/2 of the progeny from this pairing were Aneries with silver ground-color zones and the other half with pink ground-color zones. This makes six different female Aneries that gave me the same results from being paired with Salmon Snows or Sunglow Motleys.
