In corns we're not exactly there yet, but eventually we should have some corns with ringed triads that will resemble banding on milk snakes? The ground zone colors on this gender pair won't be white, but it will be interesting to see how the triads render (the pale gray blotch borders will be stark white in another year or so), rendering interesting color contrasts?
