All four of these hatchlings (Visual Hets shown for comparison only) were offered frozen/thawed pinkies when they first hatched and have never refused such meals (Hets have been sold). No other prey or alterations of pinky mice were ever offered. Like the inheritance of most Leucistic serpents, the Leucistic mutation in Gray-bands is dominant to wild-type (not recessive).
