We still don't know exactly what makes Specter corns look the way they do, there are two general schools of thought, regarding the decision, "should I get a purely Specter corn or an out-cross?". The former has the potential of getting a potentially in-bred snake and the latter poses the potential to get Specter corns with diversified ancestry—from similarly colored genes?
